WFDYS Media Consent Form

World Federation of the Deaf Youth Section (WFDYS) was established in 1995, to be the voice of the deaf youths worldwide, to train the future leaders in understanding their human rights as a deaf person, especially with the United Nations' Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD). Sign language rights, celebrating of being deaf, establishing a network support and developing leadership skills are also main focus of the WFDYS which are being delivered through their youth camps.

At the 7th Youth General Assembly in Paris, France, held in July 2019, the motion for the WFDYS' 2019 – 2023 action plan was passed. One of the points in the action plan is to collect videos to be used for our campaigns for over the next four years, to collect stories so that it could be shared at various events, such as our camps, at United Nations' side events or in our presentations. This is to spotlight the reality of our deaf youth's lives/stories and to strengthen our campaign for the improvement of the living conditions for our deaf youths, who are also our future leaders.

In Europe, there is a law called General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) that was implemented in May 2018, which means we need to explain what we are collecting, where are we storing your data, who will be accessing and why are we using it. The GDPR law also gives the person who gave their consent, the right to remove their consent at any time.

The WFDYS would like to keep all video materials to be used only for campaigns and presentations. The videos and any other related media stored will only be accessible by the WFDYS board members. The WFDYS might collect all of the information shared in the video to create statistics and stories, but the WFDYS will respect the person's right to be anonymous, such as by not sharing the person's name, but only sharing their age, gender and country the person is from unless explicitly stated otherwise.

You have the right to remove your consent at any time, with the understanding that once the video has been shared, it is not possible for the WFDYS to remove these. However, it is possible to be removed from the further sharing or inclusion in the future.
